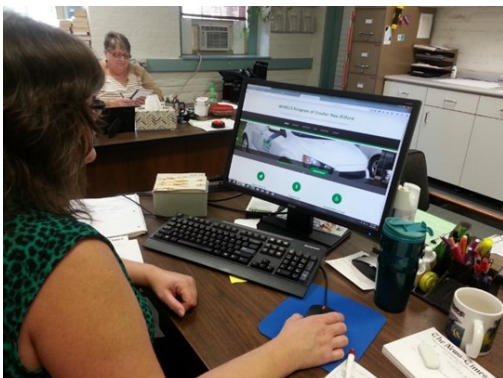

WHEELS joined numerous local organizations in receiving a donation from the New Milford Rotary Club. We are so thankful for this support from our community.



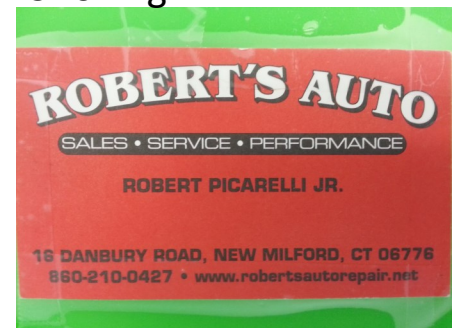

As we prepare for winter, we rely on local businesses to help keep the WHEELS rolling.



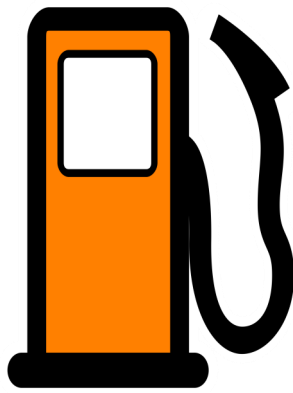
